- Military Discharge Paper-----your local service recruiter

- Marriage License-----city courthouse or state where ceremony was performed
- Divorce Decree-----city courthouse or circuit court where decree was issued
- Social Security Card----- 540-885-8959
- Credit Cards-----issuing companies
- Titles to Deeds-----city courthouse or county where property is located
- Stocks-----issuing company or your broker
- Wills-----your lawyer
- Medical Records / Prescriptions-----your physician or pharmacist
- Warranties-----issuing companies
- Income Tax Records----- 1-804-367-8031
- Auto Registration / Title-----1-804-497-7100
- Aging & Adult Services----- 540-949-7141
- Welfare Office & Food Stamp Cards-----540-942-6646
