



Virginia Webb Homicide

On 08/20/00 Officers from the Waynesboro Police Department responded to 158 South Charlotte Avenue to investigate the murder of 92 year old Virginia Cauley Webb. When Officers arrived at the residence they briefly examined the crime scene and then contacted our Investigators for assistance.

Several Officers and Investigators from the Waynesboro Police Department, assisted by Investigators from the Virginia State Police, spent the next two days thoroughly processing the crime scene and surrounding areas for physical evidence. An autopsy was conducted on 08/21/00 at the Medical Examiner's Office in Roanoke Virginia which concluded the cause of death to be asphyxiation due to strangulation.

During the next several months a task force comprised of Investigators from the Waynesboro Police Department and the Virginia State Police investigated more than 120 different leads pertaining to this case. Each of those leads was investigated to a logical conclusion. Over the past 9 years additional leads have continued to surface and all of those have been investigated to a logical conclusion as well, but this crime remains unsolved.
