- a. Encumbrance Rollforward: Appropriate encumbrances from the Fiscal Year 2020 to the Fiscal Year 2021 to various funds in the amount of \$1,245,996;
- b. School Ordinance – Unassigned Fund Balance: Appropriating Unassigned Fund balance in the Multi-year Fund, in the amount of \$51,273, to the School Funds to be used for stipends, purchased services, materials and travel;
- c. Sales and Meals Tax Revenue: Appropriating Sales and Meals Tax revenues in the amount of \$300,000 to the General Fund, for various operational increases.

- a. Schools – Planning Grant: Appropriating a Planning Grant for extended year programs/year-round school programs, in the amount of \$600,000 to the School Funds for stipends, consultants, materials and supplies;
- b. Schools – Carry Forward Virginia Tiered Systems of Support PBIS State Grant: Appropriating Carry Forward Virginia Tiered Systems of Supports (VTSS) PBIS State Grant funds, in the amount of \$19,958, to the School Funds to be used for salaries, purchased services, and supplies;
- c. Schools – Title I School Improvement Grant: Appropriating Title I School Improvement Grant funds, in the amount of \$19,574, to the School Funds to be used for teacher salaries at Wenonah elementary School;
- d. Schools – Perkins V-CTE Grant: Appropriating Perkins V-CTE Grant funds, in the amount of \$11,424, to the School Funds to be used for technology support at Waynesboro High School and Kate Collins Middle School;
- e. Schools - Augusta Health Foundation Grant: Appropriating Augusta Health community Foundation Grant funds, in the amount of \$90,000, to the School Funds to be used to purchase a food trailer.

4. Citizens may call in comments when the Public Hearing or Citizen Comment Period is opened. Calls will be answered in the order in which they are received.

 - b. When promoted, enter the access code for the meeting: 398145#
 - c. You will hear "Q&A session has started. Press *6.
 - d. You will hear "If you'd like to speak, please press 1 to be added to the queue".
 - e. Press 1.
 - f. While you are in the queue, you will hear the audio feed of the meeting.
 - g. Wait until you are prompted by the moderator, then share your comments with Council. Participants are reminded that though the prerecorded prompts refer to questions, the public hearing and citizen comment portions of the meeting are a time for Council simply to hear your comments.
