Subject:	Public Hearing on an Application by Giovanni Castro Hernandez for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to Operate a Taxi Service	

Background: Mr. Giovanni Castro Hernandez has made application in accordance with Article II Section 94-42 of the City Code for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Need to operate a taxi or vehicle for hire service in the City as GCH Taxi Service.

The purpose of the application process is to ensure the safety of the public and to assess the need for, convenience of, and benefit to the community of the proposed service. The Chief of Police has reviewed the application and does not object to its approval by City Council.

The municipal staff is working with Mr. Hernandez with respect to the proposed location of his stand/garage. The proposed use is not allowed by right at the location identified in the application.

City Manager's Recommendation: Conduct the public hearing and consider approval of the application.



Applicant hereby certifies under penalty of perjury that he has never been convicted of any violation of state or municipal law, and further agrees and stipulates that he will operate and will continue to operate the vehicle under the bona fide time the certified issued by City Council shall remain in effect, or shall promptly notify City Council at any time that he terminates the operation thereof.
8. The applicant understands that the City will conduct an investigation under Section 94-44 as to his qualifications and suitability to hold the requested certificate.
9. The applicant hereby agrees to abide by the license and other provision of Chapter 94 of the City Code with respect to the operation of this business and shall otherwise comply with all provisions of local and state law regarding the same.
10. The applicant hereby agrees to abide by City Code Section 94-43, Publication of Notice of Application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity shall be published by the applicant in some newspaper published in the city twice weekly for the two weeks prior to the date on which the application is heard.
11. Per City Code Section 94-45, for each certificate of public convenience and necessity granted under this article, there shall be paid to the city a certificate fee of \$25.00 for each vehicle for which a certificate shall be granted. No additional fee shall be charged for renewal of any certificate granted. This fee is in addition to regular license fees.
