Subject:	Designating City Holidays	

Background:

Pursuant to Council's discussion, at the December retreat, as to how to most effectively utilize City funds to enhance employee recruitment and retention, staff presents the following resolution modeled after the fourteen (14) day State holiday schedule for your consideration. The City typically recognizes eleven (11) holidays; ten as official holidays, Christmas Eve as a traditionally adopted holiday. The cost for a City holiday is approximately forty-five thousand dollars. If adopted, City staff will bring an appropriation ordinance to the next meeting in January to address the one additional holiday that falls in the current fiscal year (FY 2022). The remaining holidays will be addressed in subsequent budgets.
