**Background:** (See Background from Bulk Collection Briefing from November 14<sup>th</sup>, 2022)

At the Nov 14<sup>th</sup> business meeting Council had concerns with the fairness of the newly proposed fee (\$75) for citizens that might desire a smaller bulk pickup. There was also discussion of reducing the \$40 fee that is associated with non-compliant services.

In response, staff is proposing a two-tier pickup system where a LEVEL-1 (less than 5 cubic yards) pickup would be \$35 and a LEVEL 2 (5 to 12 cubic yards) pickup would be \$75.

Staff, in light of the amount of staff time it takes to manage a non-compliant pickups, and, as staff expects this fee to be infrequently utilized, would recommend the service fee remain at \$40. This would make the non-customer/non-compliant pickup costs to be \$75 for LEVEL-1 and \$115 for LEVEL-2.

Staff and legal counsel are working on developing an ordinance that reflects the new program parameters. This ordinance will be available in time for the November 28<sup>th</sup> Council meeting.

City Council is asked consider introducing the ordinance.

**City Manager's Recommendation:** Receive the information and consider introducing the ordinance.

**Suggested Motion(s):** Move introduction of the ordinance amending Chapter 66 of the City Code as it pertains to Bulk Collections.
