ORDINANCE NO. 2023-**



**AMENDING ARTICLE III, SECTION 82-69 ERECTION OF NO PARKING SIGNS,
SECTION 82-93 PENALTIES, SECTION 82-97 REMOVING OR ALTERING MARKS
PLACED ON THE TIRES OF PARKED VEHICLES, AND SECTION 82-101 EFFECT
OF TIMED PARKING ZONE REGULATIONS
OF THE CITY CODE OF WAYNESBORO, VIRGINIA**

Sec. 82-69. Erection of no parking signs; penalty for noncompliance with signs.

The City Manager or his duly authorized representative may post no parking signs on any of the City streets, when necessary, in the City Manager's or representative's sole discretion, to facilitate the moving of traffic or the removal of snow, ice, leaves, or other debris upon such. Any person who violates this Section by parking a motor vehicle on a City street so designated with no parking signs shall upon conviction be fined \$20.00.

Sec. 82-93. Same—Penalties.

- (a) Each owner receiving a notice of violation of this Division shall, within seven days of the time when such notice was attached to such vehicle, pay to the Police Department a penalty for and in full satisfaction of such violation in the sum of \$20.00 for each violation of the provisions of this Division, with the exceptions of Section 82-70 (Parking of Oversize Vehicles), which is \$50.00 per offense, and Section 82-62(12) (Handicapped Parking), which is \$100 per offense.
- (b) The continued overtime parking of such vehicle more than 24 hours after the prior violation of overtime parking shall constitute a separate violation.
- (c) The failure of such owner or operator to make such payments at the Police Department, or mail the payment, within seven days shall render such owner subject to the penalties provided for the violation of the provision of this Chapter.
- (d) It shall be unlawful for any person other than the owner or authorized driver of a vehicle to remove a parking ordinance violation ticket notice from such vehicle except with the permission of the owner thereof.
- (e) Any person wishing to contest a parking citation must complete a Parking Ordinance Violation Appeal Form provided by the Waynesboro Police Department.
- (f) If the contested parking citation is upheld through administrative review by the Waynesboro Police Department, the parking citation shall be certified on an appropriate form to the Waynesboro District Court by such official(s);
- (g) The Waynesboro Police Department shall cause complaints, summons, or warrants to be issued for delinquent parking citations pursuant to Virginia Code section 46.2-1225; and

- (h) Every action to collect unpaid parking citation penalties imposed for a violation of the City Code regulating parking under this Article shall be commenced within three years of the date upon which such penalty became delinquent.

Sec. 82-97. Removing, altering, etc., marks placed on tire of parked vehicle by police officer or other parking enforcement personnel.

- (a) It shall be unlawful for any person to cover up or in any manner remove, alter, or tamper with any chalk mark or other mark, which has been placed on the tire of a vehicle by any police officer or other city parking enforcement personnel acting on behalf of the City, in order to measure the length of time such vehicle has been parked in a particular parking space, while such vehicle is parked on the public streets, or parking lot of this City.
- (b) Any person convicted of violating any provision of this Section shall be punished by a fine of \$20.00.

Sec. 82-101. Effect of timed parking zone regulations upon other parking regulations.

Nothing in this Division shall alter or affect any existing ordinance, rule, or regulation, or any ordinance, rule, or regulation adopted, relating to traffic or parking on any other street, alley, public parking lot, lane, or highway within the City, other than those included within the timed parking zones herein established.
