**A RESOLUTION OF SUPPORT FOR A VIRGINIA HIGHWAY SAFETY IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (VHSIP) APPLICATION FOR INTERSECTION SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS IN WAYNESBORO, VIRGINIA**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Waynesboro submitted Virginia Highway Safety Improvement Program (VHSIP) Applications for intersection safety improvements; and

**WHEREAS**, the following six local systemic safety initiatives have been identified as part of Virginia’s Highway Safety Investment Strategy: high visibility signal backplates, flashing yellow arrows, pedestrian crossings, road diets, unsignalized intersections, and curve delineation; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Waynesboro’s VHSIP applications submitted October 2023 included pedestrian crossing treatments, unsignalized intersection improvements, and curve delineation improvements; and

**WHEREAS**, the application for curve delineation treatments addresses a curve in East Main Street near the intersection of East Main Street and Hunter Street; and

**WHEREAS**, the application for the unsignalized intersections will address nine intersections including: W. Broad St. and New Hope Rd, King Ave. and Bridge Ave., Delphine Ave. and Windsor Rd., Poplar Ave. and Ohio St., Delphine Ave. and B St., W. Broad St. and Park Rd., S. Wayne Ave. and 13<sup>th</sup> St., King Ave. and Hopeman Pkwy., and W. Main St. and Magnolia Ave.; and

**WHEREAS**, the applications for pedestrian crossing improvements will address the following locations: 4<sup>th</sup> St. and Delphine, S. Wayne/Rife Rd/Arch Ave./Lyndhurst Rd., Lyndhurst Rd. mid-block near Jefferson Ave., Lyndhurst Rd. and Valley Rd., Lyndhurst Rd. and Meadowbrook Rd., Poplar crossing near High School, W. Main St./Downey Dr./Battlefield Blvd., Rosser Ave. and Northgate, Bridge Ave. and Essex Ave., Hopeman Pkwy at Food Lion, Hopeman Pkwy and King Avenue; West Hopeman Pkwy and Bridge Ave., Delphine and B. St, Broad St. and Park Rd., Wayne and 13<sup>th</sup> St., Wayne and 14<sup>th</sup> St., Main St. and Magnolia Ave., B St. and Hamlet, C St. and Ivanhoe, Ivy St. and Anthony Cir., mid-block of Ivy St. between Anthony Cir. and Link Rd., Ivy St. and Link Rd. Ivy St. and Howard Ave., Ivy St. and Edward Ave., and Ivy St. and Loudoun Ave.;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the City Council of Waynesboro hereby fully supports the HSIP applications, as described.
