

Electoral Board Minutes for Election Result Canvass held on June 13, 2018 **Pertaining to Primary Elections held on Tuesday, June 12, 2018**

Elizabeth Bouldin-Clopton, Chair of the Waynesboro Electoral Board called the board into session at 9:12a on June 13, 2018.

In attendance: Elizabeth Bouldin-Clopton, Chair, Robert Horowitz, Secretary of the Waynesboro Electoral Board, Lisa Jeffers, Waynesboro Registrar, and Marsha Howard, witness representing the Waynesboro Republican Party Committee.

The Electoral Board (EB going forward) decided to open and work on each Ward separately. Robert Horowitz, Secretary of the Waynesboro EB opened the Red Bag for each ward to review election result data.

Wards A, B, C, D and CAP

Envelopes 1A, 1B, 2A, 2, 3, 4, 6 & 8 were all sealed and signed by OE.

Envelope 7 was sealed with all contents included.

Envelopes 1A & 1B were empty since no provisional ballots were cast.

Envelope 2 A

The Printed Returns Form was signed and the signed zero, results and write in tapes were attached.

Closing Check List was filled and signed. Thumb drive Pollbooks separated by Registrar. Officers of election oaths were signed. The incident reports were included. Poll Book Entry Slips were there. Ballot Sheet Was filled and signed. Statement of Returns were signed and signed zero, results and write in tapes were attached. The Secretary read, the Electoral Board Chair confirmed, and the Registrar verified vote results.

After verifying contents, The EB sealed and signed all Envelopes.

Total votes cast:

Ward A: Republican Primary: 66; Democratic Primary: 61; Total Votes cast: 127

Ward B: Republican Primary: 214; Democratic Primary: 197; Total Votes cast: 411

Ward C: Republican Primary: 139; Democratic Primary: 127; Total Votes cast: 266

Ward D: Republican Primary: 270; Democratic Primary: 204; Total Votes cast: 414

CAP: Republican Primary: 17; Democratic Primary: 18; Total Votes cast: 35

Total votes cast in the City of Waynesboro: 1,313 or 9.95% of registered voters.

The winning nominees:

Corey Stewart won the Republican nomination for U.S. Senate with 335 (0.475%) out of 706 votes cast in the Republican Primary.

Jennifer Lewis won the Democratic nomination for 6th District U.S. Congressperson with 478 (0.787%) out of 607 votes cast in the Democratic Primary.

All election numbers reported on Election Night were OK as checked. Total votes cast in the City of Waynesboro for this Primary Election were: 1,313 or 9.95% of registered voters. See below: Voting Tally.¹

Abstracts verifying results that Corey Stewart won as Republican Candidate for the U.S. Senate representing The Commonwealth of Virginia and that Jennifer Lewis won as the Democratic Candidate representing the 6th Congressional District in the Commonwealth of Virginia were signed by Electoral Board Members and sealed with Waynesboro Electoral Board Seal.

The Canvass for the June 12th Primary Elections for Republican Candidate for U.S. Senate representing the Commonwealth of Virginia and Democratic Candidate for Congressperson Representing the 6th Congressional District of the Commonwealth of Virginia in Waynesboro, Virginia was closed, and the election certified at 10:30 AM.

The Chair moved, and the Secretary seconded that The Electoral Board stay in session to discuss other issues.

The Electoral Board and Registrar wishes to record that they are very pleased with the excellent performance of all our Officers of Election. The EB and the Registrar noted that the revised Closing Check List contributed to the proper completion of closing procedures of all the Wards and helped make the Canvass go smoothly and efficiently.

The EB discussed the need for a third Electoral Board Member and the hope that the Waynesboro Republican Party Committee appoint nominees for the position as soon as possible. It is of concern that the EB will be understaffed and without proper representation for the upcoming U.S. Senate and U.S. Congressperson elections on November 6, 2018.

The Electoral Board and Registrar noted its disappointment at the poor voter turnout for the Primary. The board will begin working more diligently to assist in educating the public on the importance of voting, especially in non-presidential election cycles, and to support the registration of more voters. That topic will be addressed along with the annual Registrar performance review at their next meeting on Friday, July 6, 2018 at 8AM.

The Chair moved, and the Secretary seconded that the EB meeting be adjourned. It was approved, and the Electoral Board Meeting on June 13, 2018 was adjourned at 10:57am.
