PRE-BUSINESS MEETING REVIEW:

The City Manager reviewed the agenda for the upcoming regular business meeting.

The Community Development Block Grant discussion included a highlight of the five-year consolidated plan and the annual action plan, with a focus on the Basic City infrastructure, street lighting and the impact of geography. It included a brief discussion on the buildings owned by Fishburne Military School on Commerce Avenue.

The City Manager noted that an application deadline for participation in the Downtown Christmas Parade will be more strictly enforced for the smooth planning and implementation of the event.

Bids were received for the Florence Avenue Bridge Replacement Project, which came in higher than anticipated. Additional funding sources were briefly discussed.

The City Manager and the City Attorney will address the recent distribution of KKK flyers around the City.
