

**ORDINANCE NUMBER 2016-79**



**AN ORDINANCE TO  
AMEND THE CITY CODE BY ADDING A NEW SECTION  
ESTABLISHING A FOOD TRUCK VENDOR LICENSE**

***BE IT ORDAINED*** by the City Council of the City of Waynesboro that the City Code be and is hereby amended by the addition of the following.

**Food Truck Vendor License**

Any person engaged in the retail selling of food or non-alcoholic beverages from a food truck shall pay a license fee of \$100.00 per annum. The license fee shall not be pro-rated or transferable. The 'annum' period shall begin January 1 and end December 31 of each year. The license holder shall still be subject to the collection of all sales and other taxes applicable to the sale of food and non-alcoholic beverages within the City's limits.

A food truck shall include both a motorized vehicle from which the sale of food and non-alcoholic beverages are purchased, and a trailer which is transported by another vehicle, from which trailer the food and non-alcoholic beverages are purchased.

This Food Truck Vendor License shall be in lieu of any itinerant or peddlers license.

This ordinance shall take effect at 12:59 PM of December 31, 2016.
