An illicit discharge is anything running to the storm sewer which is not composed entirely of rainwater. Examples include:

1. Sewage, industrial wastes, yard wastes, oil, paint and other wastes poured onto driveways, sidewalks, parking lots, the ground, or any other areas draining to the storm sewer system;
2. Cross Connecting any sanitary sewer to the storm sewer system, including floor drains or washing machine drains
3. Placing, or depositing anything into the storm sewer system that could interfere with the flow of stormwater or effect water quality

The City of Wayneboro has an Illicit Discharge Ordinance Code Sec 30-101:109



“The City of Waynesboro finds uncontrolled discharges of pollutants into the storm sewer system has an adverse impact on the quality of receiving waters.”
